

Statement for recommendation to Academic Senate as part of preamble to DTC Technology Master Plan

May 2020 ETC the passed (3 to 1) the following resolution to go to Exec when they next meet:

The Technology Plan at Napa Valley College (NVC) defines critical needs and technology trends for the next five years. As such, it represents a roadmap of where we need to go with instructional and information technology implementation. The Technology Plan recognizes the need for a governance structure that mandates coordination of instructional and institutional technology and recognizes different functions—particularly in the relationship with selection; planning; and administration of technology resources.

September 2020, Revised as Statement (suggestions by Academic Senate President and ETC Chair):

The Technology Plan at Napa Valley College (NVC) defines technology trends and critical needs (educational technology equipment and software) for the next five years. As such, the Technology Plan represents a roadmap, which gives the District direction in the allocation of resources towards educational and information technology at NVC. The Technology Plan recognizes the need for a governance structure that affirms and reflects the coordination between educational and institutional technology. This structure reflects and recognizes the differences in purpose and functions of educational and institutional technologies, taking these differences into consideration when planning and administering institutional resources for technology.
