### Free Access to the *New York Times*

The McCarthy Library is pleased to provide our Students, Faculty and Staff with **full digital access to the *New York Times Newspaper* for 2017-18 year (February 28, 2017 to February 28, 2018) on campus and off.**

Along with digital access to the news, *New York Times in Education* is a resource to provide faculty with instructional strategies for the classroom and the campus with co-curricular activities.

### Setting up your Account

1. We recommend that students, faculty and staff use their campus email address (through Outlook).
2. Initially, from a **CAMPUS COMPUTER**, you will create a username and password (This is because the NYT will authenticate based on our campus IP address).
3. Navigate to [Accessnytimes.com](http://Accessnytimes.com) (while connected to a **NVC campus IP address**).
4. Search for and click the listing for Napa Valley College.
5. Click “Create Account” and complete registration fields.
6. Test your login at [www.nytimes.com](http://www.nytimes.com).
