Asian Art Museum: China's Terracotta Warriors. Feb 22-May 27, 2013. This exhibit includes ten figures only—a representative sample of the actual army which (to date) includes over 8,000 excavated life-sized figures and over 10,000 weapons.

Museum of the African Diaspora: The Kinsey Collection. Feb 8- May 19, 2013. One of the largest private collections of African American artifacts, documents and artwork will be on display.

San Jose Museum of Art: Raging Opulence: Mark Dean Veca. Sept 29, 2012 to March 31, 2013. If you have the desire to see how 18th century opulence and 20th century cartoons, comic and street art combine, you won't want to miss this amazing and colorful exhibit!
