- ▶ Nexis-Lexis is one of the library's databases that can come in mighty handy for students who need company information. It is an ideal resource for Business, Economics, and Accounting majors.
- ▶ The most common LexisNexis searches are right there on the front page of the database and include:
 - News (1980 to today)
 - Legal Info. (U.S. & state cases)
 - Company Information (covers 43 million companies)
 - Countries (Socio-economic profiles & news)
 - People (covers public figures).

- ▶ LexisNexis provides a full range of credible sources for business information, including business and financial news, U.S. and international company financial information from government or private sources, market research, industry reports, and actual SEC filings. Search features permit comparison of companies based on criteria such as sales, income and number of employees.
- ▶ Financial information sources include *Standard & Poor's Corporate Descriptions*, *Hoover's Company Reports*, *Disclosure Reports*, *IRRC*, international company and stock reports, and more.
- ▶ LexisNexis also provides easy access to key references resources, including polls and surveys from the Roper Center for Public Opinion Research, biographical information, country and state profiles, and the World Almanac and Book of Facts.
