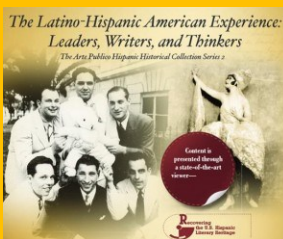
Academic Video Online (AVON hosted by Alexander Street): A comprehensive video subscription that delivers over 70,000 titles, spans a wide range of subject areas, and includes an additional 14,000 titles as part of Alexander Street (curated, discipline-focused primary-source collections, websites and streaming media for learning and research).



HeinOnline: Contains millions of pages of historical and government documents, as well as over 2800 law-related periodicals. You can find the entire Congressional Record, Federal Register, and Code of Federal Regulations as well as U.S. Reports going back to 1754. In addition, HeinOnline's database contains treaties, constitutions, case law, international trade, foreign relations, U.S Presidents and much more!



Hospitality & Tourism Complete: A trusted and unique full-text database covering all areas of hospitality and tourism, including hospitality law, market trends, food and beverage management and hotel management. In addition to hundreds of full-text journals, it provides magazines, company and country reports, books and newspapers.



Latino-Hispanic American Experience: Leaders, Writers, and Thinkers digital collection. This EBSCO digital resource is the second series of the *Arte Público Hispanic Historical Collection* and consists of newspapers, letters, advertisements, and other primary source documents covering Latino-Hispanic civil rights, religion, and women's rights.
