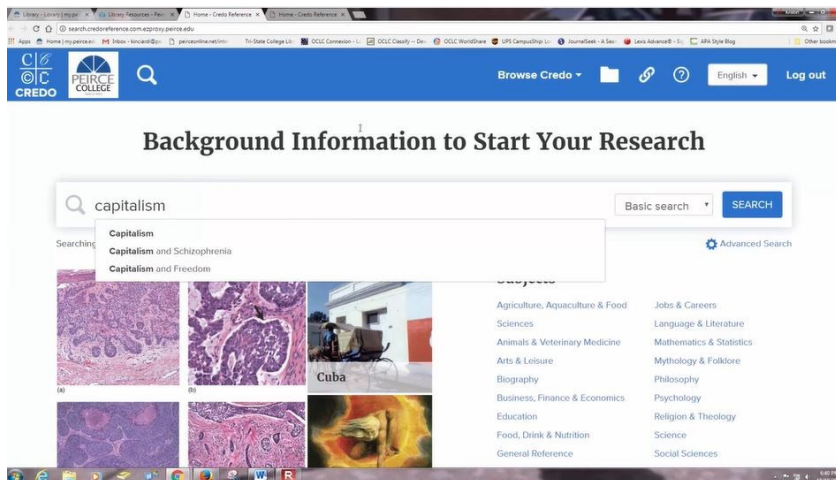
This week, the McCarthy Library is highlighting Credo Reference Database. Credo offers over 3,000,000 reference entries from all the major academic subject areas and serves as a great starting point for your research! Tons of images, audio files, videos and full-text articles on any topic you can think of, all with full citations.

Think of Credo as the academic alternative to Wikipedia! It contains fact-based and citable information. This database contains reference e-books, topic pages, and links to additional McCarthy library databases and materials.
