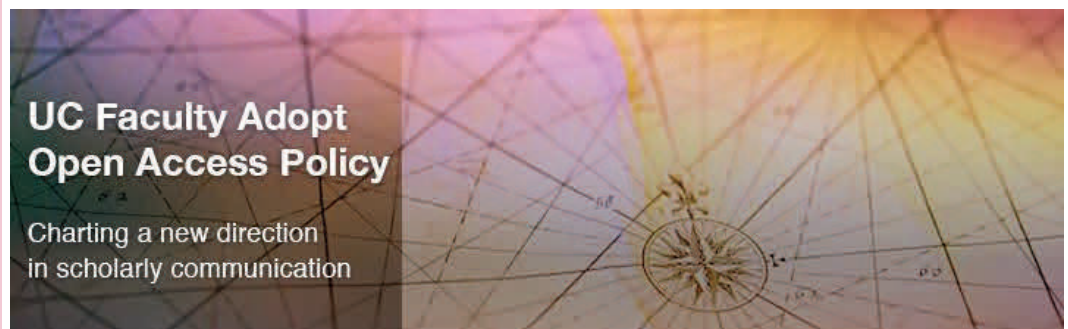
▶ **eScholarship** provides Open-Access scholarly publishing to the University of California and makes articles available to the public at no charge. Articles are made public in tandem with their publication in scholarly journals. The Academic Senate of the University of California just passed an Open Access Policy on July 24, 2013, ensuring that future research articles authored by faculty at all 10 campuses of UC will be made freely available to the public. According to their [recent press release](#): “Open access benefits researchers, educational institutions, businesses, research funders and the public by accelerating the pace of research, discovery and innovation and contributing to the mission of advancing knowledge and encouraging new ideas and services.”

This is a fantastic repository now available to NVC faculty, staff and students.
